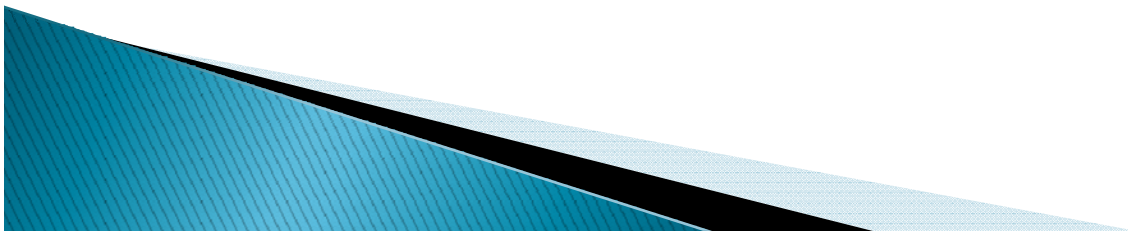

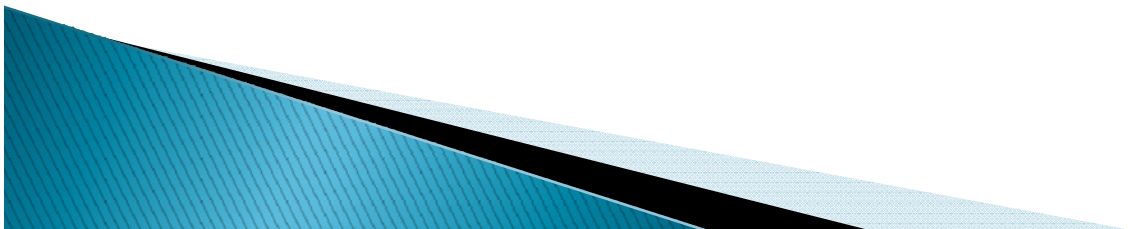
INTRODUCTION

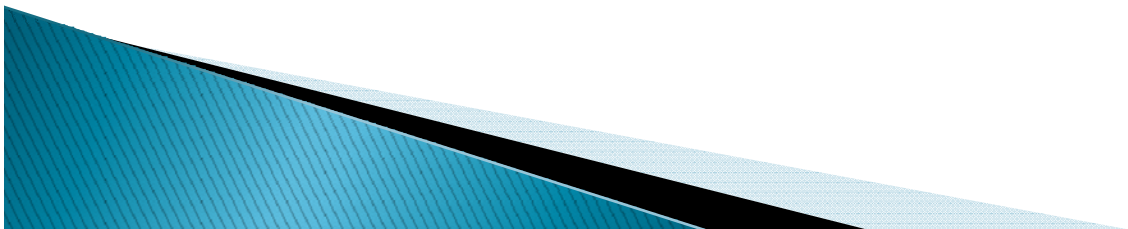
Activities and Accomplishments

- Good Governance and accountability needs to be developed



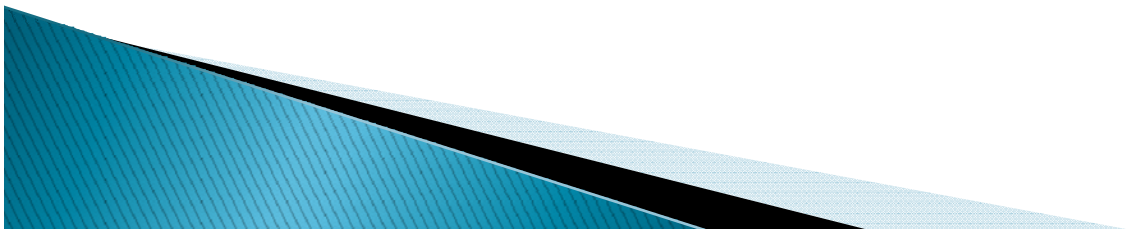
Activities and Accomplishments
