will be open to Health Directors or Managers responsible for health administration in the First Nation, Society or Tribal Council.

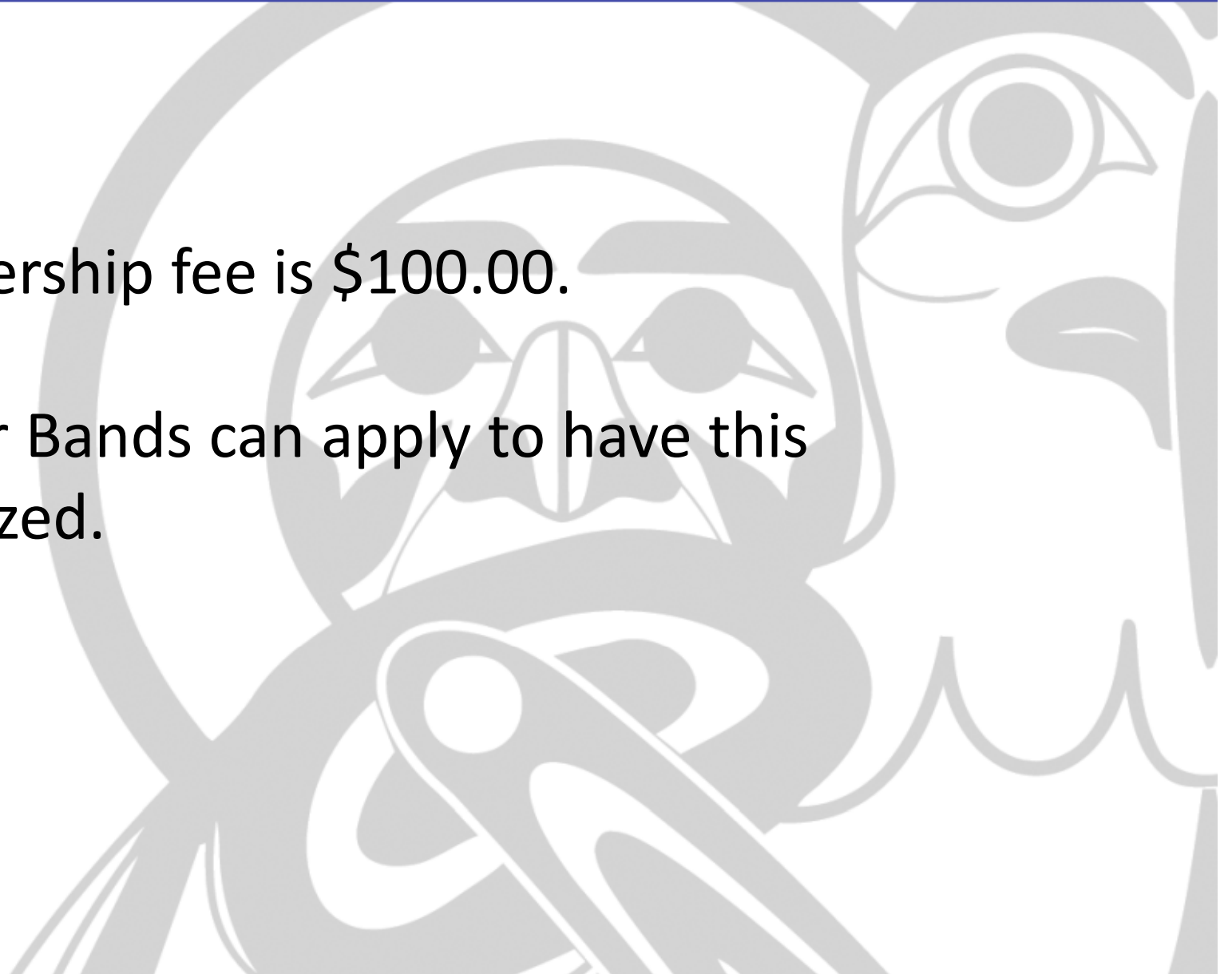
## **Associate Membership:**

Smaller Bands can apply to have this subsidized.

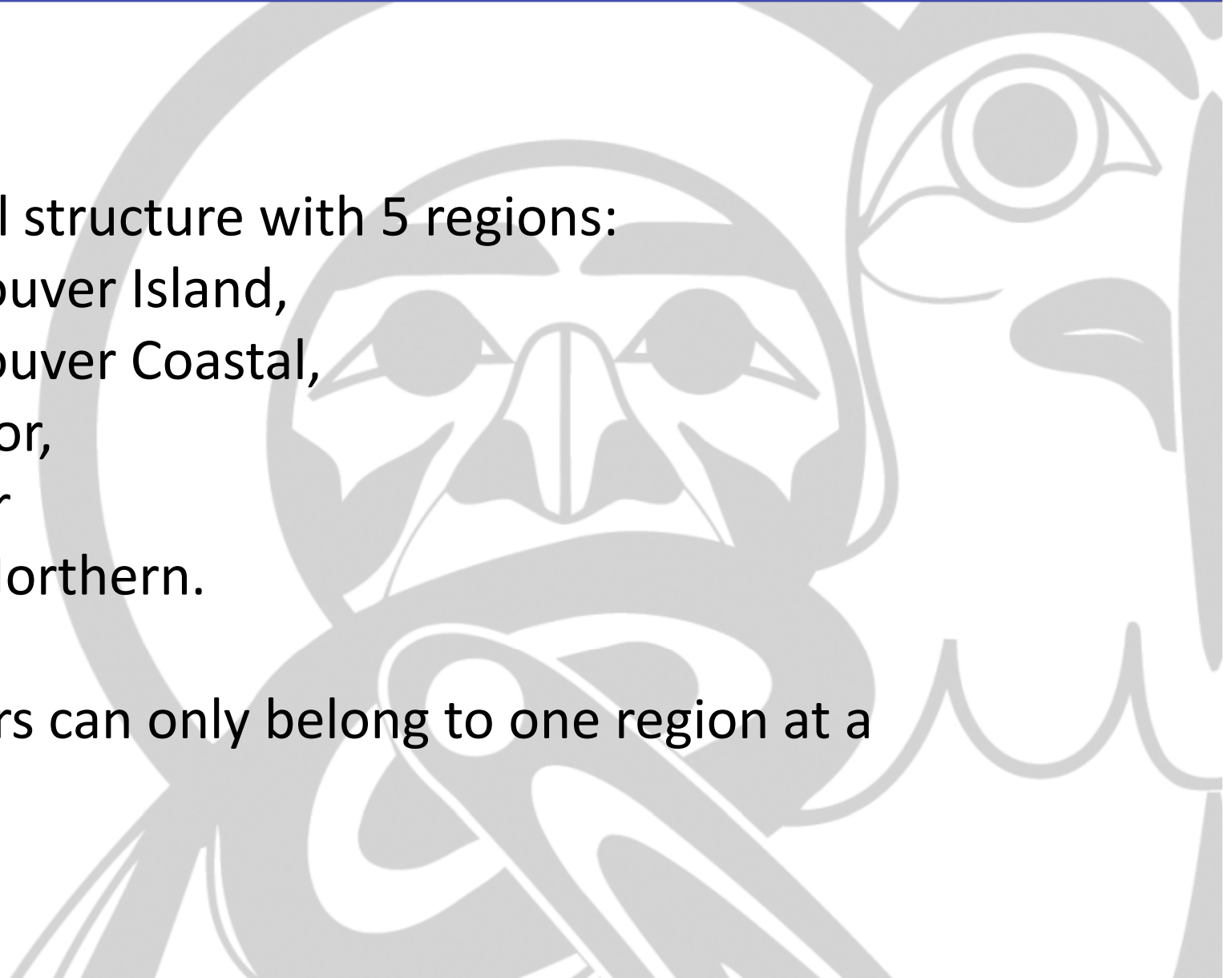


# Regional Structure

Regional structure with 5 regions:

- Vancouver Island,
- Vancouver Coastal,
- Interior,
- Fraser
- and Northern.

Members can only belong to one region at a time.



# Voting

## **Full Members in good standing:**

1. Have the right to one (1) vote.
2. Can elect director(s) for his/her region

## **Associate Members:**

1. Do not have the right to vote.

# Proxy Voting

- Full Members can vote by proxy at annual or special General Meetings.
- Board Members, because of their legal responsibility to the Association, do not vote at Board meetings by proxy.
