HOME CARE NURSE

Temporary Part –Time (20-25 hours per week)

The Musqueam Indian Band, which is located in Vancouver near the University of British Columbia, is seeking a temporary part-time Home Care Nurse to work Monday to Friday 20-25 hours per a week. You will be a talented professional to manage and evaluate the delivery of care for clients of all ages with acute, chronic or palliative health needs in the Musqueam community. The position is subject to on-going funding.

This role offers great rewards for the right individual, offering a challenging and exciting work environment with the opportunity to work closely with the Musqueam community.

Reporting to the Health Program Manager the Home Care Nurse will manage and evaluate the delivery of care for clients of all ages with acute, chronic or palliative health needs in the Musqueam community.

Duties:

- Identifies community members requiring home care support
- Completes a client assessment that includes development of a care plan, determination of service allocation and on-going reassessment
- Collaboration with the home care agency and other community resources to provide in-home personal care/home management services to meet the needs of the client
- Assists with discharge planning for those community members being discharged from the hospital
- Ensures that clients in the Musqueam community have access to medical supplies and equipment
- Participates in case management and family conferences as appropriate
- Makes appropriate client referrals to other health care professionals and community resources
- Provides clients and family caregivers with health information as required through teaching sessions

- Provides supervision, direction, and support for the Home Support Worker
- Completes and submits service delivery data and reports as required by First Nations and Inuit Home and Community Care Program
- Maintains client confidentiality and ensures that all records are stored securely
- Maintains CRNBC's Standards of Practice through attendance at workshops, conferences and additional training opportunities
- Maintains professional support and consultation to ensure the program is delivered in a safe effective manner
- Coordinates community education workshops with a strong focus on the Aboriginal Diabetes Initiative program

Job Knowledge:

The work requires the following knowledge, skill and/or abilities:

- Nursing registration and membership with the College of Registered Nurses of British Columbia (CRNBC).
- Graduation from a recognized nursing program combined with more than two years' recent related experience in an acute care medical/surgical setting
- Knowledge and experience of similar program delivery in a First Nations environment is preferred
- Knowledge and understanding of First Nations communities, health and social issues
- Cultural competency and knowledge of the MIB's cultural traditions an asset
- Creating opportunities to facilitate clients' understanding and participation in health and healing initiatives
- Coordination of and involvement in multidisciplinary teams
- Tolerance and sensitivity to the needs of every individual and their right to be treated with respect and fairness
- Self-directed with demonstrated organizational skills
- Excellent written and interpersonal communication skills
- Ability to maintain a professional demeanor and confidentiality
- Skill in the use of workplace technology, i.e. computers, communications equipment, business software.
