- The First Nations eHealth Strategic Plan Project will engage First Nations communities and partners to develop an initial Strategic Plan that will be utilized to identify and guide ongoing and future investments and initiatives. The project team will collaborate with the BC FN eHealth COE in moving this project forward.

Tripartite Role:

- The Tripartite partners (Federal & Provincial governments and the FN Health Council) have committed funding and resources to support the development of the FN eHealth Strategic Plan.
- The Tripartite parties provide input to the planning efforts through the FN eHealth Strategy Council.

Objectives & Benefit

- Review and capture of data in support of development of a Current State Assessment. This deliverable will identify current and planned activities related to First Nations eHealth at the community, Health Authority, Provincial and Federal level.
- Develop a Community Engagement process, including communications and data capture tools.
- Review and align the initial First Nations eHealth Strategic Plan with Provincial and Federal eHealth plans.

Recent Activities:

Current State Assessment and Engagement Process deliverables are being finalized.

Next Steps:

- Engagement with First Nations communities, Health Authorities and Provincial and Federal partners.
- Develop initial draft of First Nations eHealth Strategic Plan. Target completion is February 2010.
